


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?





2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?






4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.








17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching

- Students wish for more practical-oriented activities which again were halted by Covid-19.
- Student need more skills oriented programmes.

Actions to be taken

IQAC would initiate following steps to meet the students' expectations

- Teachers would be asked to undertake the mentoring work more rigorously as the college has almost come back to normalcy.
- Teachers would be asked to discuss in detail the students' performance in the internal assessment.
- Wherever possible, teachers will be advised to conduct practical activities like field visits, projects and presentations.
- College will organise skills development programmes along with entrepreneurship development programmes.
- College will organise Career Advancement Course to complement the syllabi.
- College will strengthen the mentor-mentee system, especially after the Covid outbreak. Personal counselling along with academic counselling will be arranged on the campus.
- IQAC will play a proactive role in keeping teachers abreast with new domains of knowledge so that students will be the ultimate beneficiaries.
