WHAT IS RAGGING?

Ragging is any conduct by a student, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.

TYPES OF RAGGING

- 1. Physical ragging: Physical abuse, pushing, hitting, or forcing someone to do something against their will.
- 2. Verbal ragging: Using abusive language, teasing, or making fun of someone.
- 3. Psychological ragging: Isolating, intimidating, or humiliating someone.

PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING

Ragging is a serious offense and will be dealt with strictly. Any student found guilty of ragging will face the following consequences:

- 1. Suspension from classes
- 2. Expulsion from the college
- 3. Fine or penalty
- 4. Police action, if necessary
