## POLICY

**Introduction:**

H.P.T. Arts & R.Y.K. Science College, Nashik, having a reputation of the pioneering educational institution in North Maharashtra, has vision of 'Education for All' and also set forth its mission as 'to bring the minorities and marginalized communities into the mainstream of development.' As a part of the Mission, our college supports the students by way of awarding them with scholarships and freeships. Scholarships and freeships are awarded to students not only by our educational institution but also private entities as recommended by the College. The College also gives away endowment prizes from the amount received from the staff, students and well-wishers.

The policy for awarding scholarships and free ships is as follows:

**Scope:**

This policy applies to all students enrolled in undergraduate and postgraduate programs at HPT Arts & RYK Science College, Nashik.

**Objectives:**

1. To recognize and reward academic excellence and outstanding achievements of students.
2. To provide financial assistance to students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.
3. To promote diversity and inclusivity by supporting students from underrepresented groups.
4. To encourage meritorious students by providing prizes for their academic achievements

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. **Special Category Scholarships: (as applicable)**
  - Students belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) as per government norms
  - Students with disabilities, as certified by a competent authority

## **2. Need-based Freeships:**

- Students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, as determined by the college's financial aid committee
- Students who have faced unforeseen financial hardships, such as loss of a parent or guardian, medical emergencies, or natural disasters

## **3. Prizes:**

- Students who have achieved academic excellence in the University examinations

### **Application and Selection Process:**

1. Students must submit their applications for scholarships and freeships within the specified deadline.
2. The Principal in consultation with IQAC and Management will review and evaluate the applications based on the eligibility criteria and award criteria.
3. The college administration will be final and binding.
4. For endowment prizes, the Student Development Board prepare list of meritorious students for giving away endowment prizes.

### **Review and Revision:**

This policy will be reviewed and revised as necessary, with changes effective from the next academic year. The college reserves the right to modify or withdraw scholarships and freeships at any time. The present policy is revised on 31/05/2024.


### **Policy Guidelines:**

- The college is committed to provide all scholarships provided by Govt. Maharashtra/Central Government and other government agencies to all eligible students.
- The college is committed to provide all freeships provided by Govt. Maharashtra/Central Government and other government agencies to all eligible students.

- The college is committed to provide all scholarships to girls students provided by Govt. Maharashtra/Central Government and other government agencies to all eligible students.
- The College endeavours to collect funds for poor /meritorious students from various sectors. Financial assistance is given to students through these agencies.
- Scholarship sanctioned to the students by the Government were credited on their saving accounts in the Nationalize Banks.
- Government of Maharashtra does not give any sanction letter of scholarship and free-ships to any institutions in Maharashtra. Manual scholarship correspondence was stopped from the academic year 2010-11. Correspondence regarding scholarship is done online from the same academic year.
- All the information and documents of scholarship of students are submitted online by the students. The amount of scholarship is sanctioned as per the documents attached. The institute gets all the details about sanctioned scholarship of online portal. The details regarding the scholarship such as bill number, date of the bill, caste, academic year, number of students, scholarship amount of the student, share of the college and the date of credit amount on the account of students are available on Scholarship Portal.
- The endowment prizes will be given away during the Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony every year. The lists of prize givers and prize winners are maintained by Student Development Board.
