 - To create procedures for fostering collaborations with other institutions/industry/Govt. & Non-Govt. organizations
 - To create awareness on environment friendly practices in daily institutional activity;
 - To promote overall development of students by promoting extra-curricular, cocurricular activities which are conducive to academic activity;
 - To train staff & students through various specially designed programmes to update knowledge and skill sets;
- To realign the institutional working in tune with National Education Policy-2020; • To develop a system for conscious, consistent & catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institution.

Roles of IQAC Department

1. Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the institution
2. Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process
3. Arrangement for feedback response from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes
4. Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education
5. Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles
6. Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement
7. Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices
8. Development and maintenance of institutional database through dedicated ERP for the purpose of maintaining/enhancing the institutional quality
9. Conduct of various audits to ensure the continuous improvement
10. Development of Quality Culture in the institution
11. Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC

Steps initiated by IQAC in Academics

1. Framing the College **Academic Calendar** for every Indigenous year
2. Execution of the **Lecture Monitoring Committee** (LMC): for monitoring lectures and practicals of teachers during the college hours, for checking quality of content taught and its relevance with the syllabi prescribed and for observing the teaching methodology adapted by teachers.
3. Strategizing innovative ways for **Continuous Internal Evaluation** (CIE): It includes conducting Internal Exams, Field visit report making and assessment, Competency Mapping, Personality Development and Analysis, Exhibitions and Contests, Weekly Research paper seminar evaluation, Project presentation viva-voce, Practical Performance Evaluation, Orientation Programs and Assessment
4. Analysis and Interpretation of **Results**: For every program the percentage of students passing as against the total number of students enrolled for every academic year.

Role of IQAC in composing the Plan of Action and the Action Taken Reports

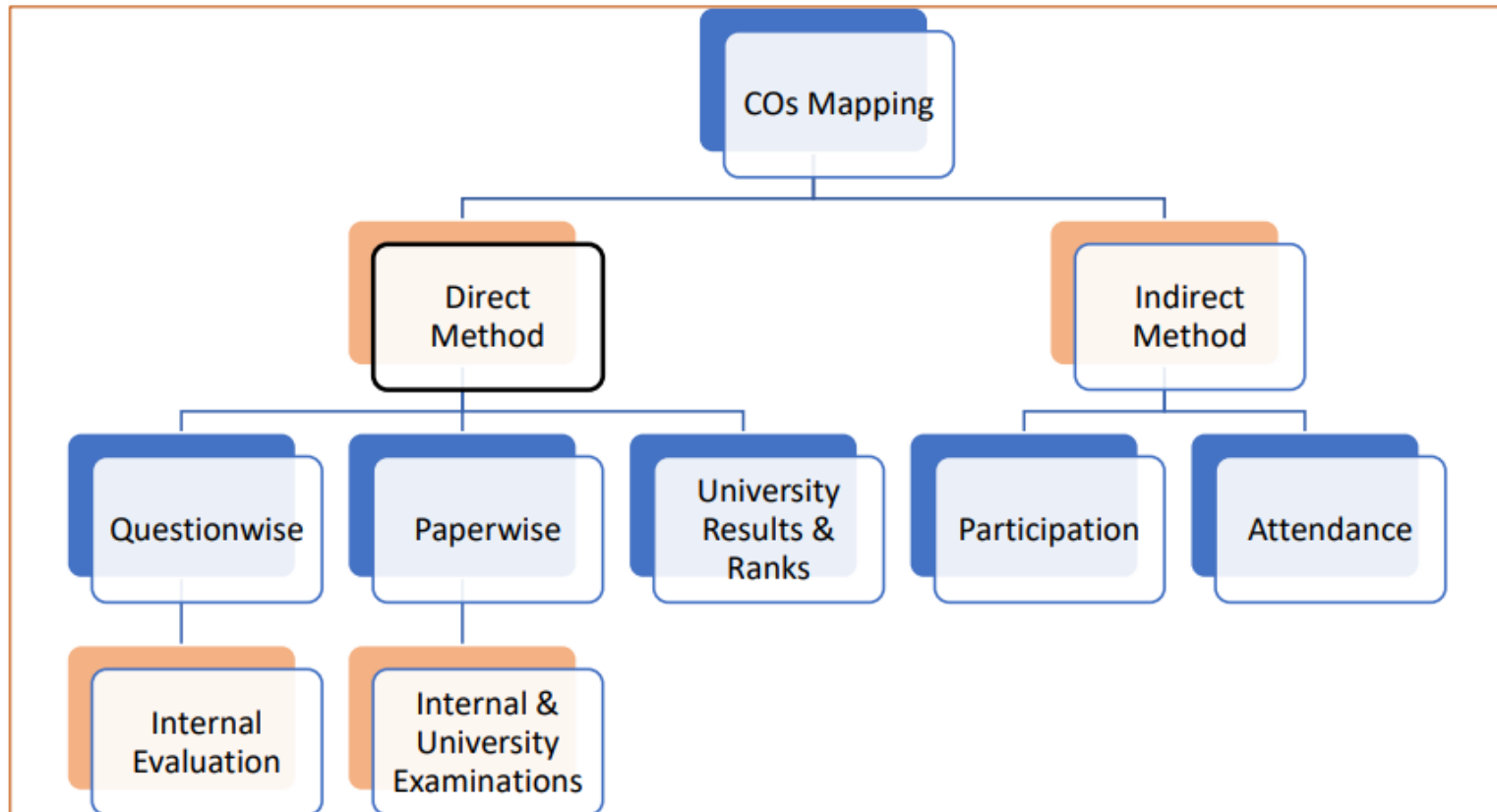
1. Conducting meetings for **academic calendar** planning and various college or department level audits

Role of IQAC in measuring the attainment of POs and COs

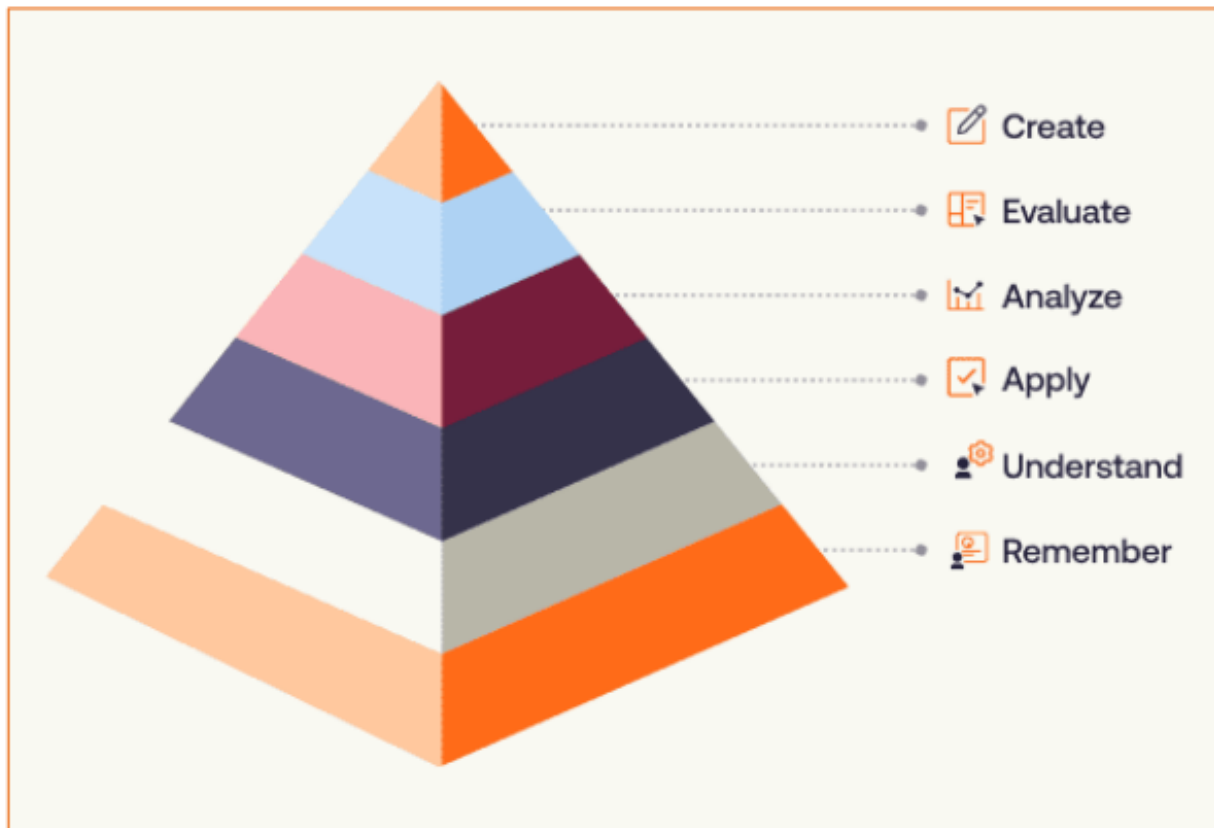
Methods Adapted for COs Mapping

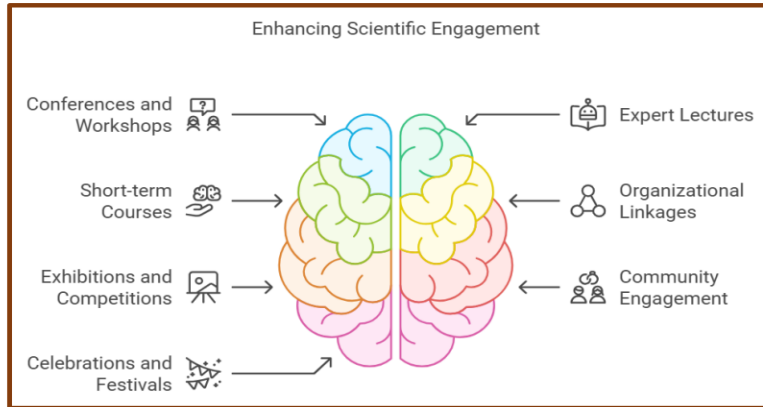

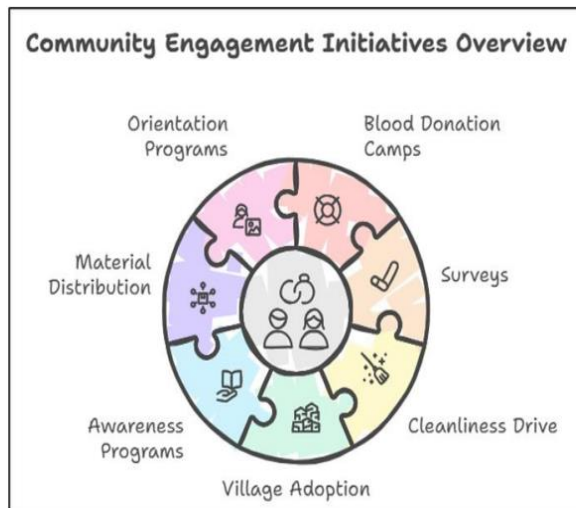

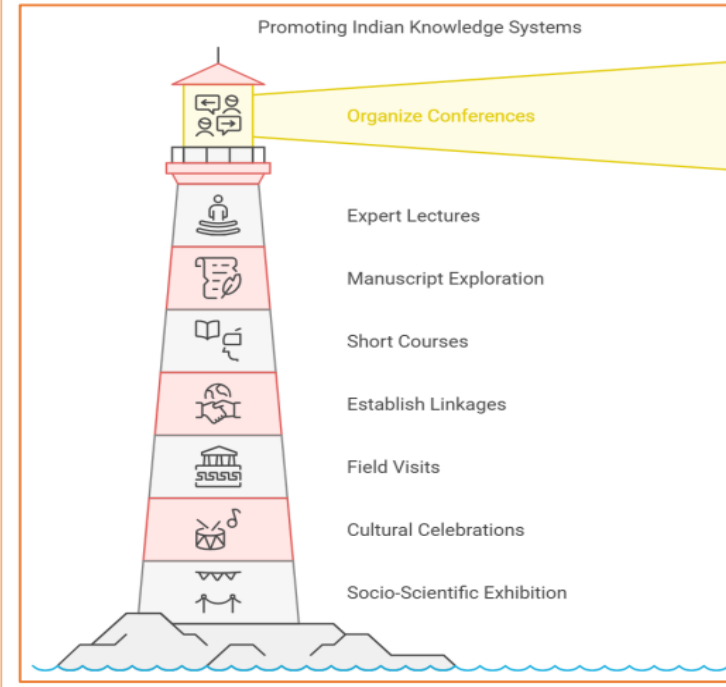
