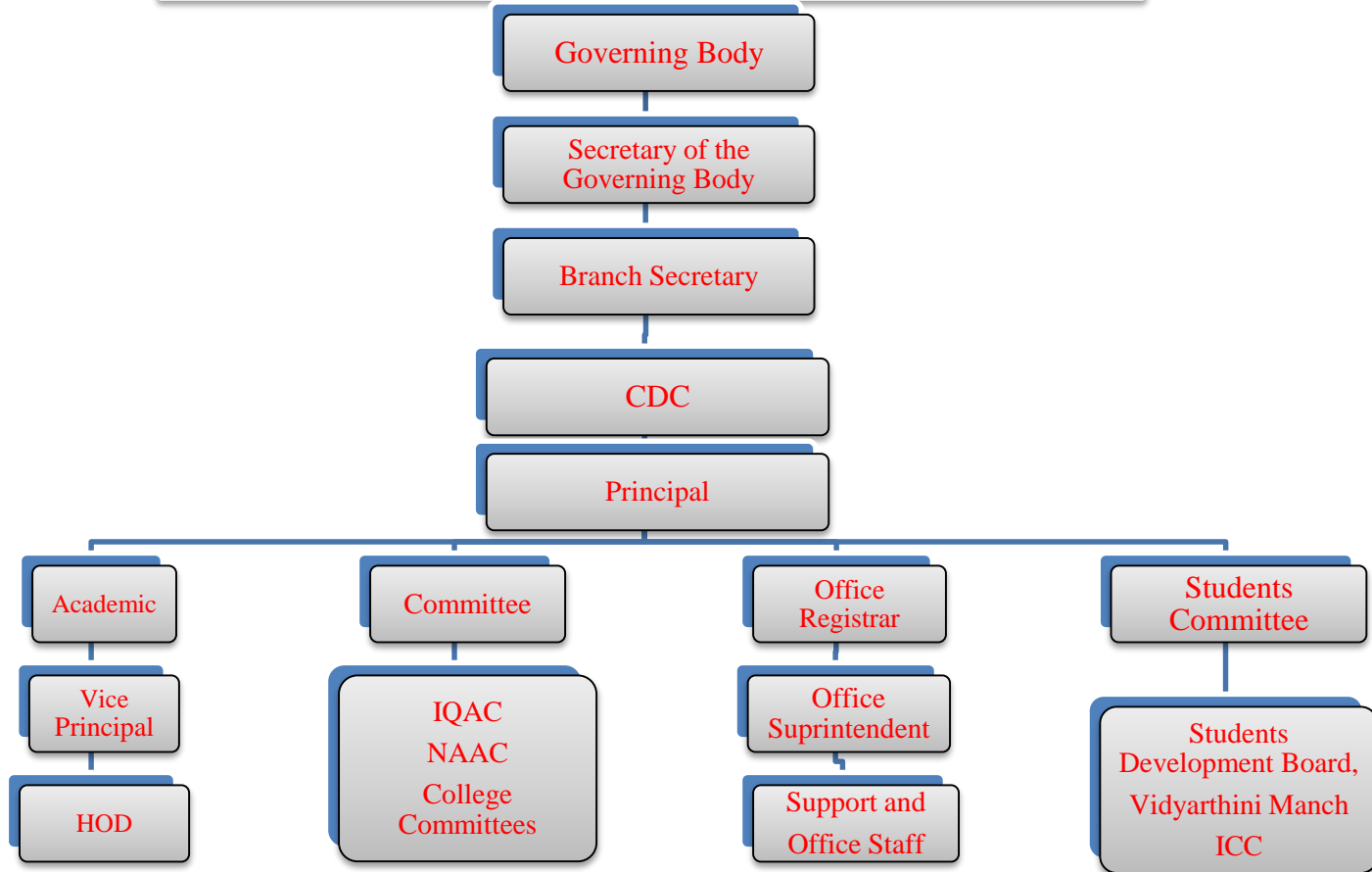

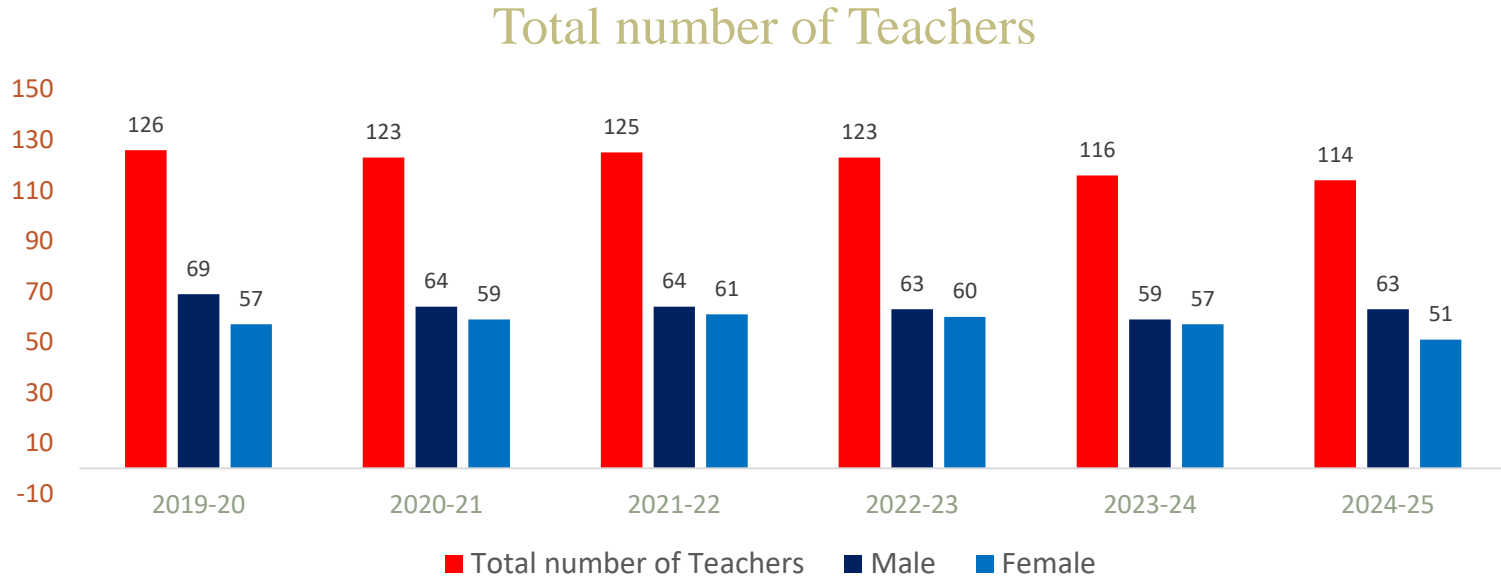

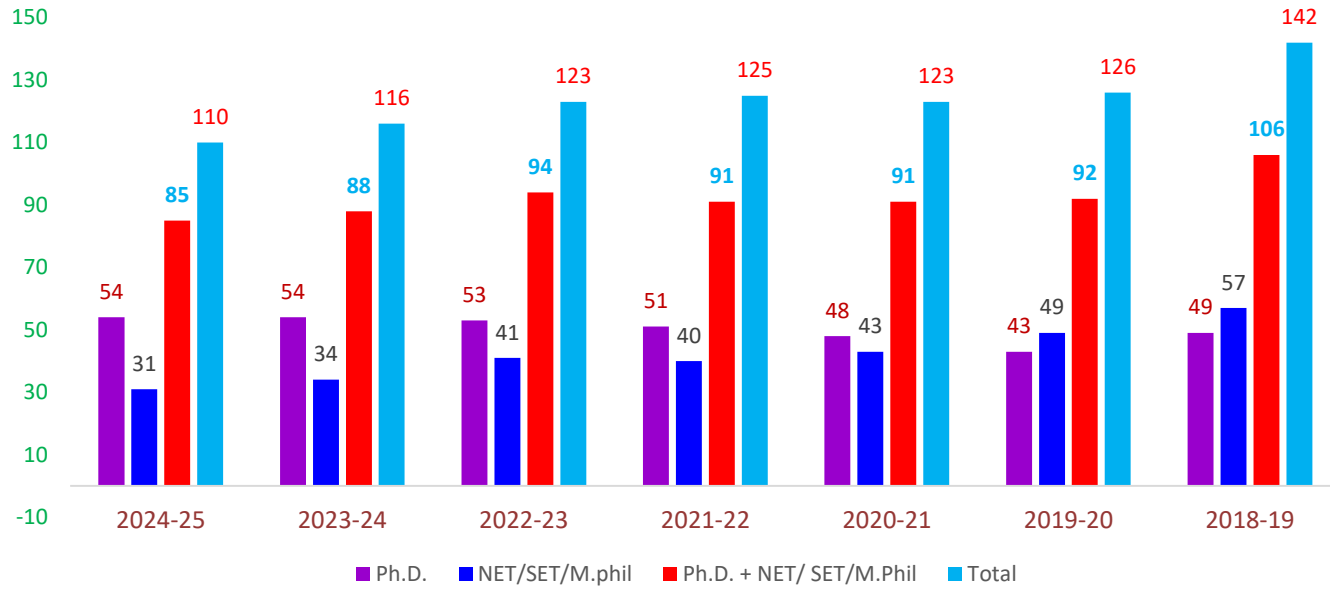
Total Teaching staff Proportion of Ladies and Gents Staff

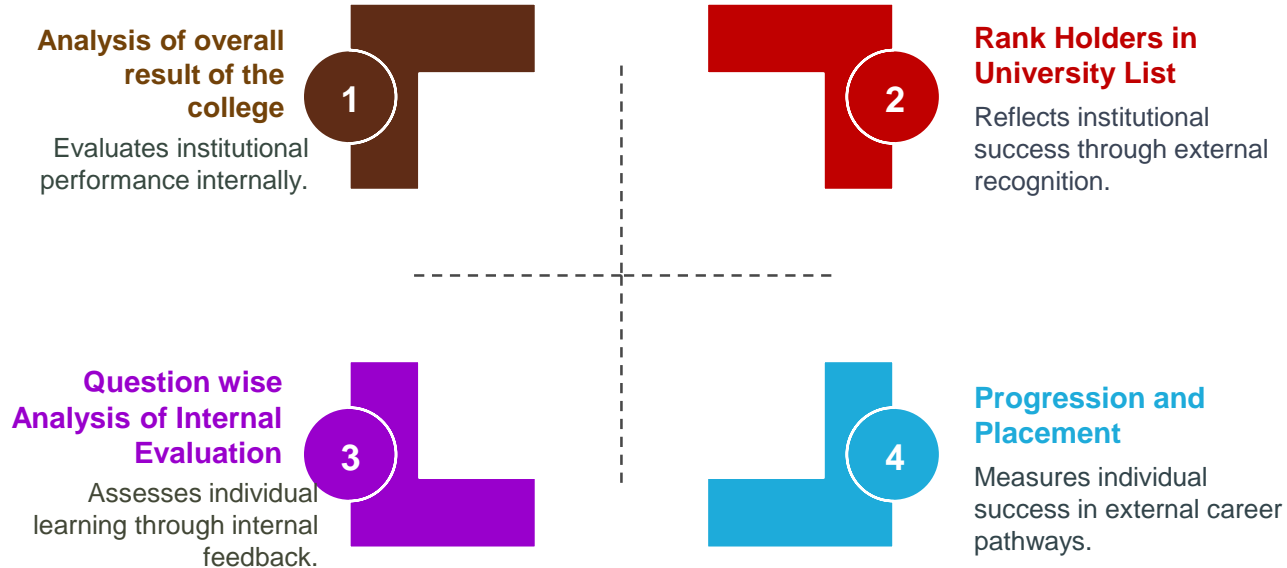

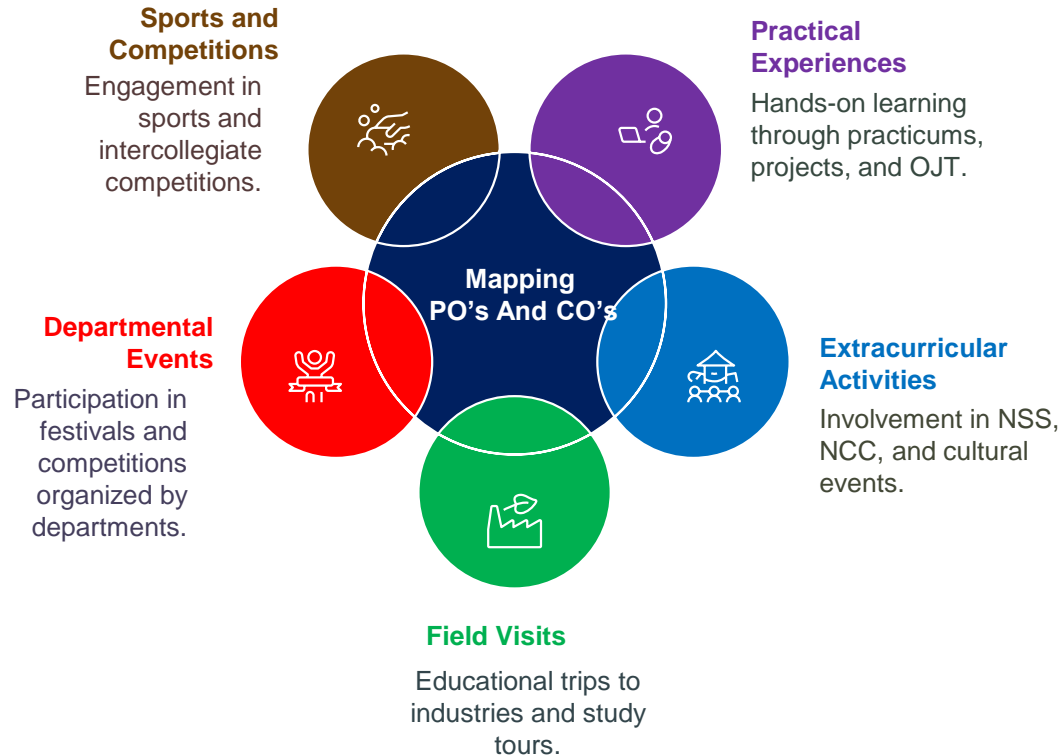
Academic Calendar

- 4) The internal evaluation is done as per the plan. Various methods of evaluations are used . Written tests, home assignments, practical tests ,oral exams, field visit reports etc

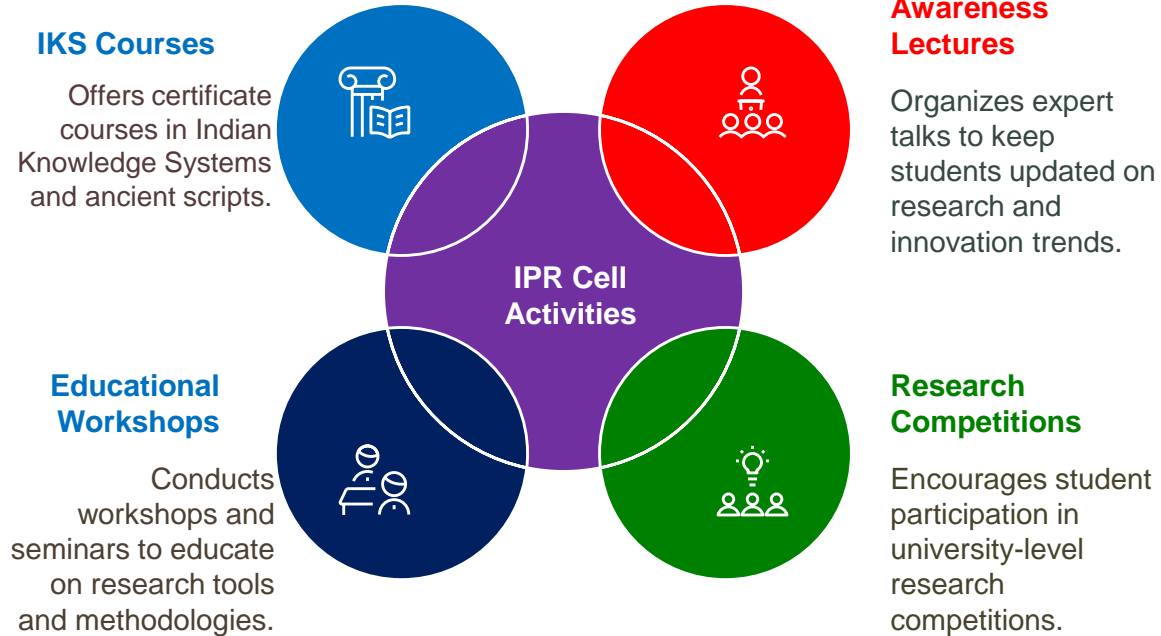
Direct Methods of Measurement of Attainments of POs and COs

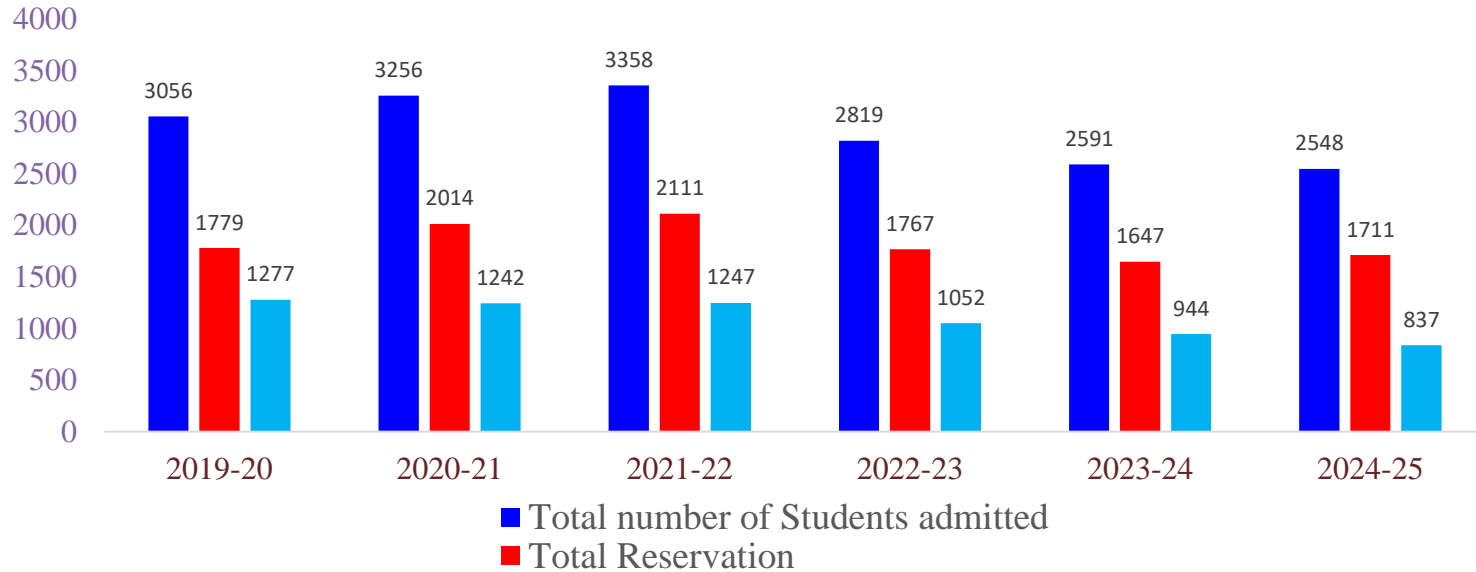

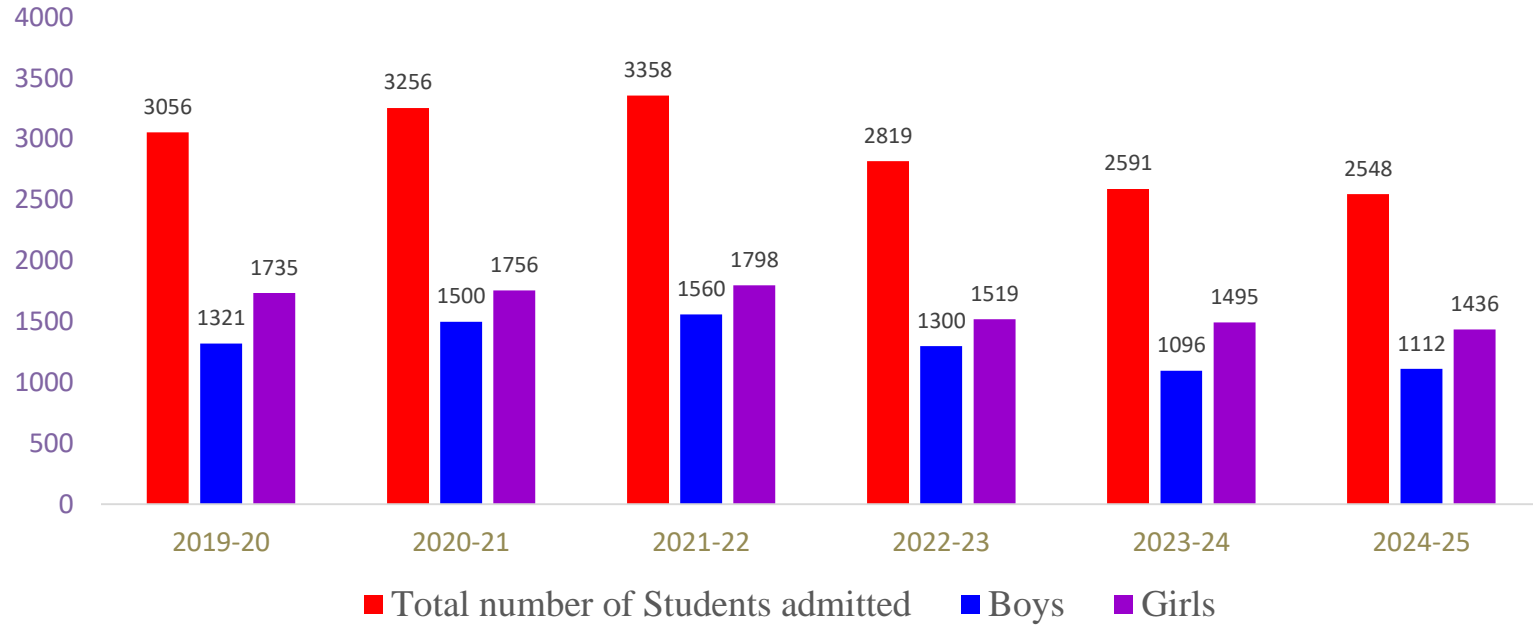
Chart shows the proportion of reservation and general students for 2018-2022

Chart shows the proportion of boys and girls for 2018-2022

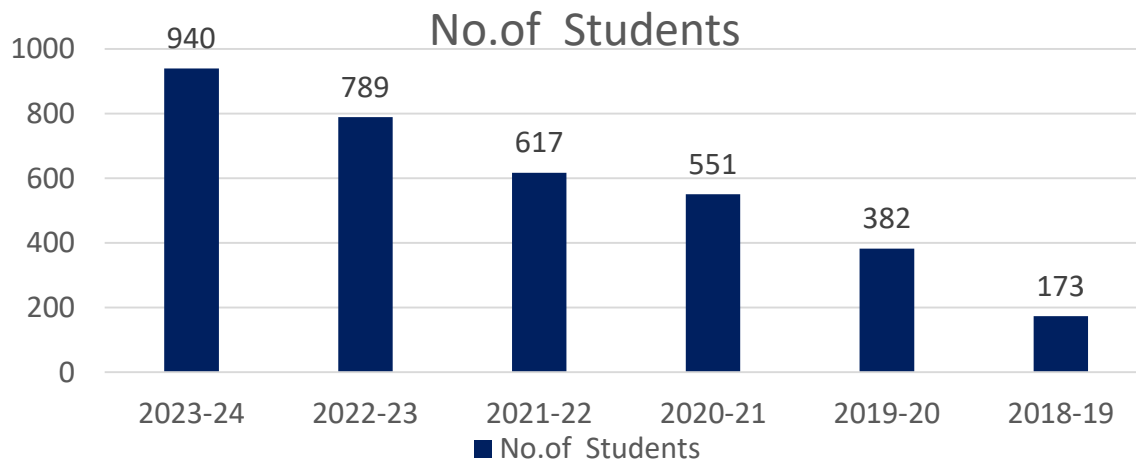

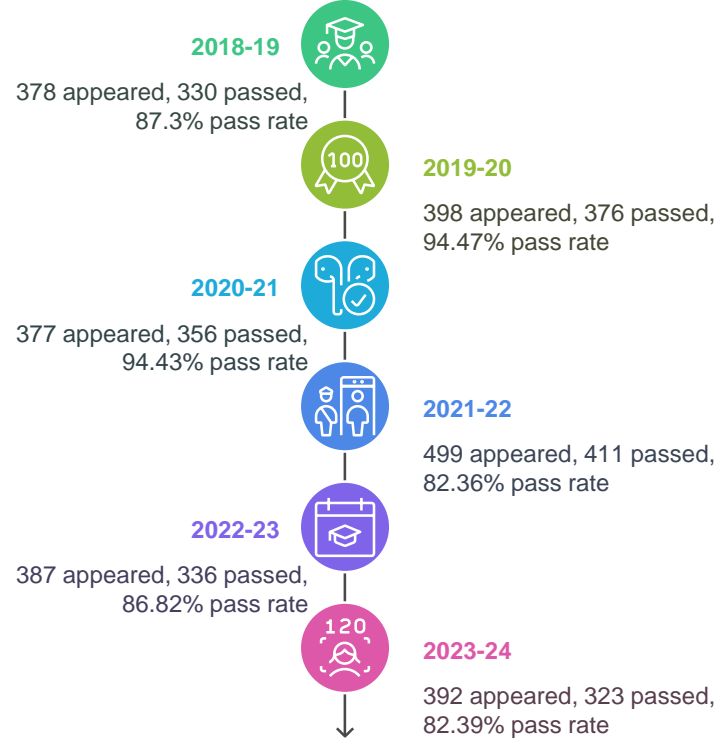

UG Pass percentage of Students during last Six years

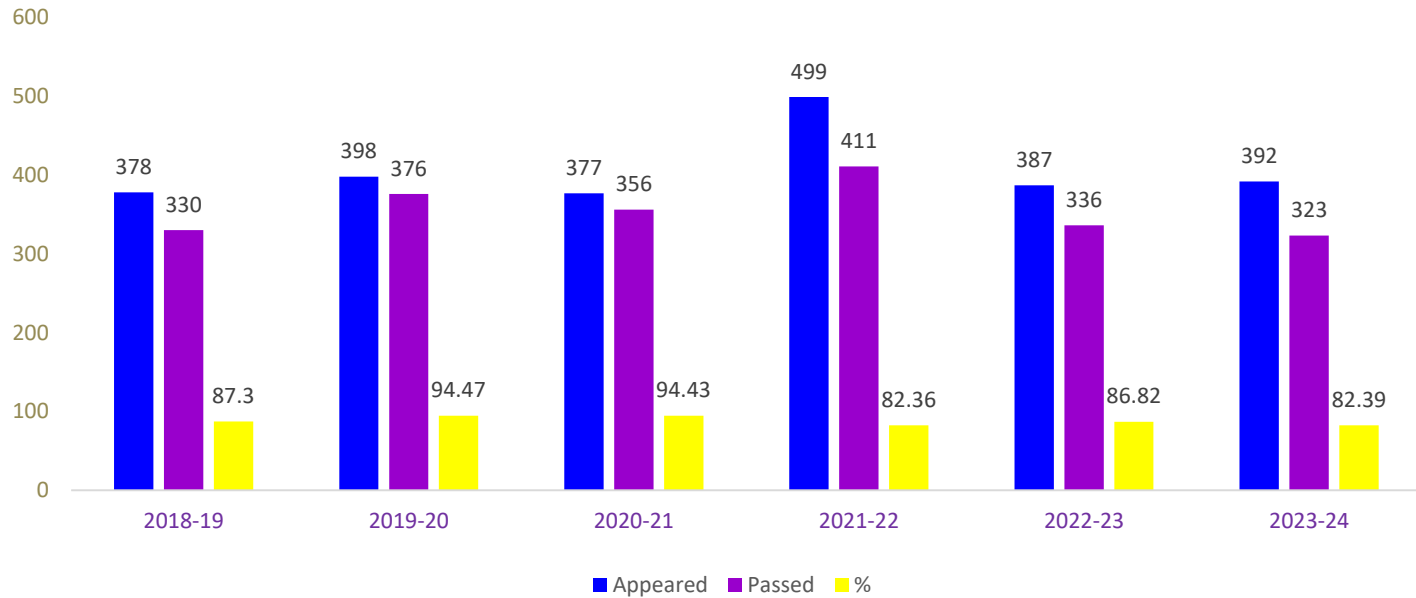


PG Classes Pass Percentage Over Six Years

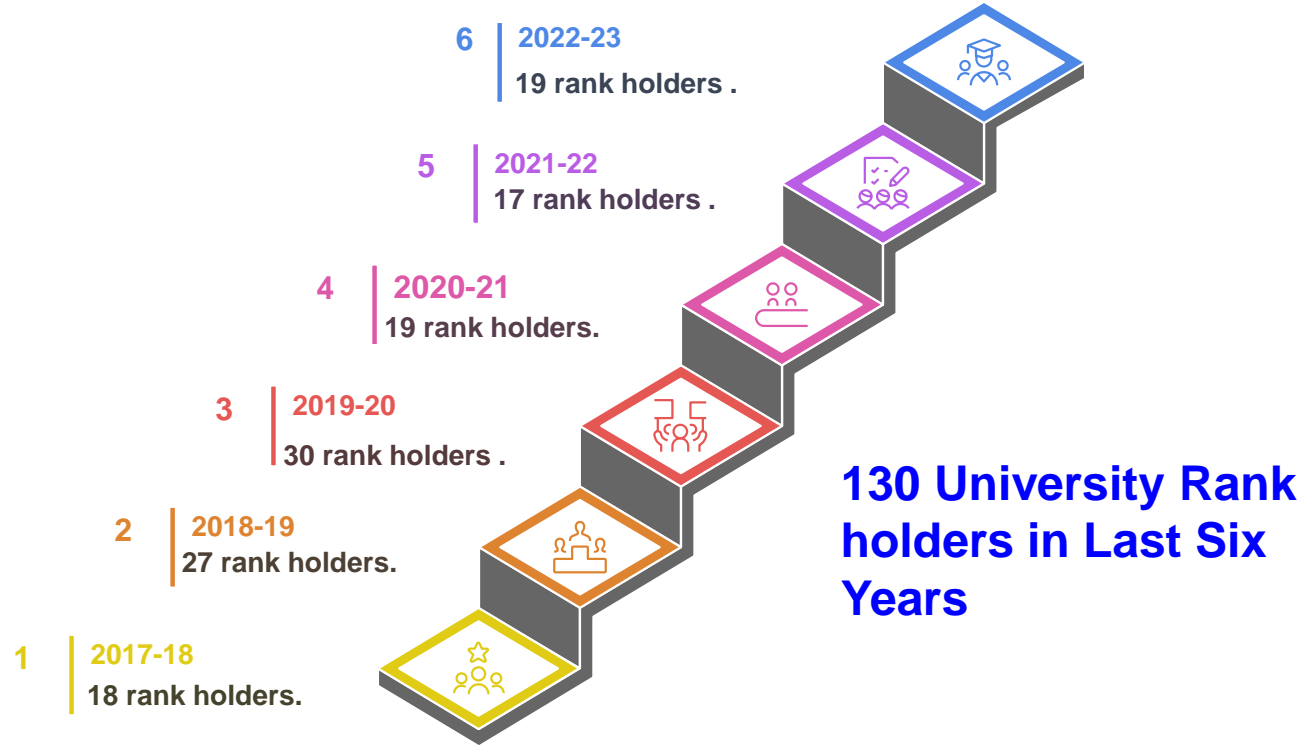

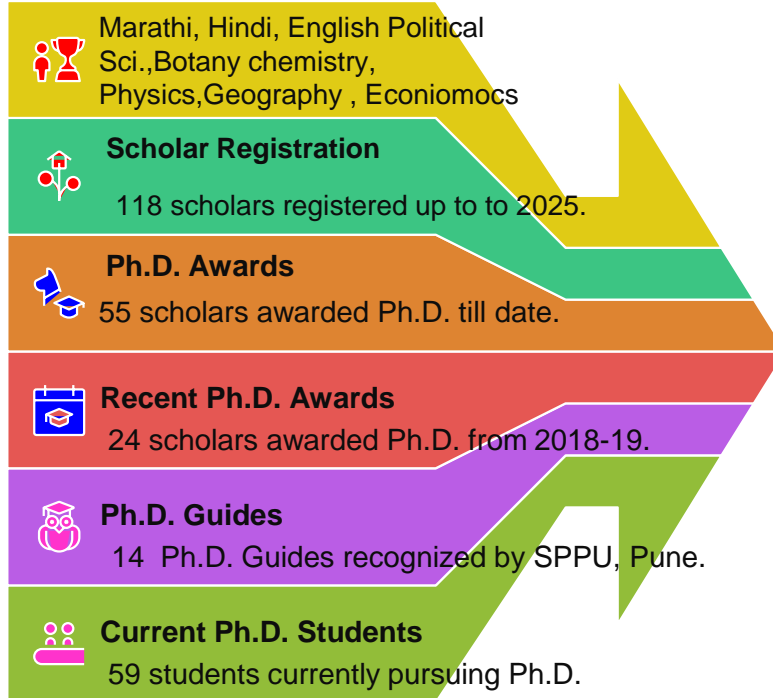
PG Pass percentage of Students during last Six years

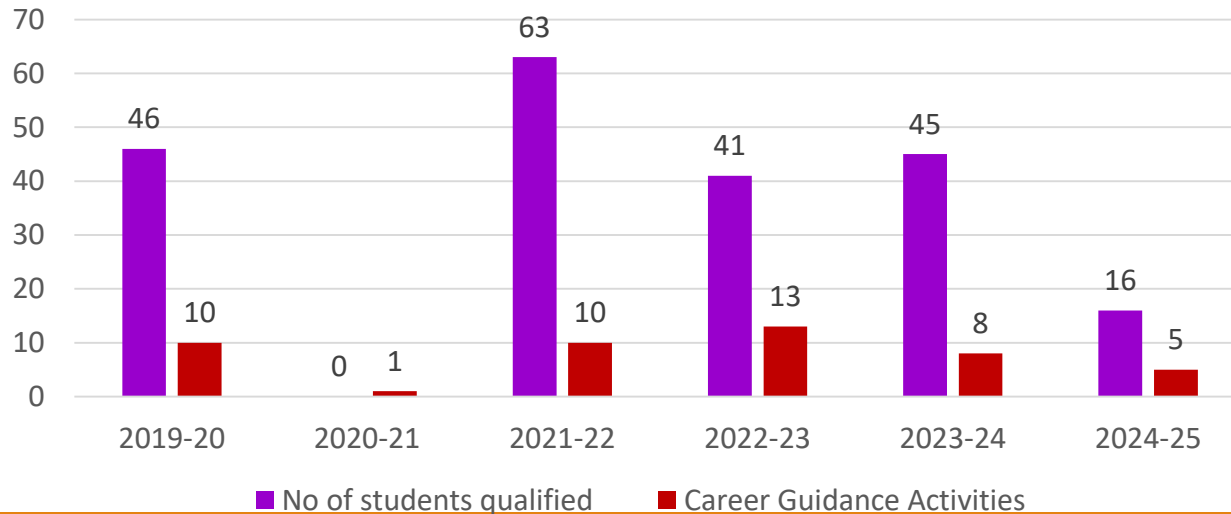
